- Psalm 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.
- Psalm 25:1 To You, O Lord, I lift up my soul.
- Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
- Psalm 119:11 Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You.
- Psalm 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.
- Psalm 146:1 Praise the Lord! Praise the Lord, O my soul.
- Psalms 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!
